Born in West Malaysia, Ian spent his formative years in Singapore and came to Australia as a young man to study. He has lived and worked in Fremantle since 1981.

Ian exhibits nationally and internationally. His most recent overseas exhibition was in Lodeve France where he first began to paint seriously. The recipient of a number of awards, his work is represented in private and corporate collections worldwide.

Possessing a talent for capturing the fundamentals, or essence of his subjects, Ian's skill is very much evident in the 2010 Fremantle Festival image. Expressive brushwork, a vibrancy of colour and simplicity of design truly capture the energy and movement of the two circus performers within the frame – an apt visual analogy for the Fremantle Festival, WA's premier community arts and cultural festival.

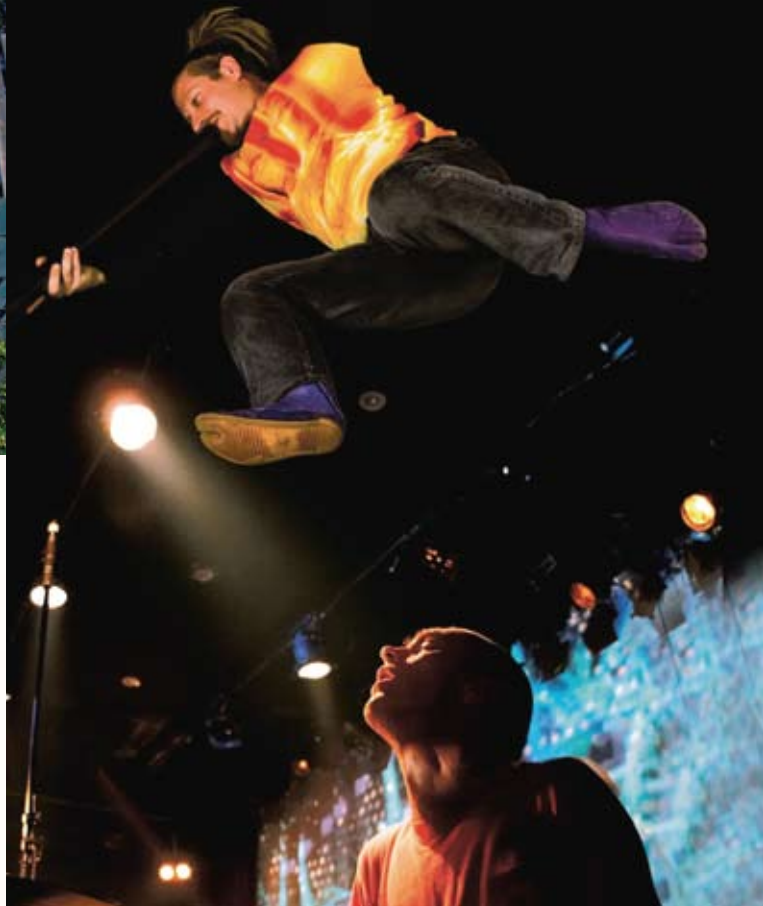

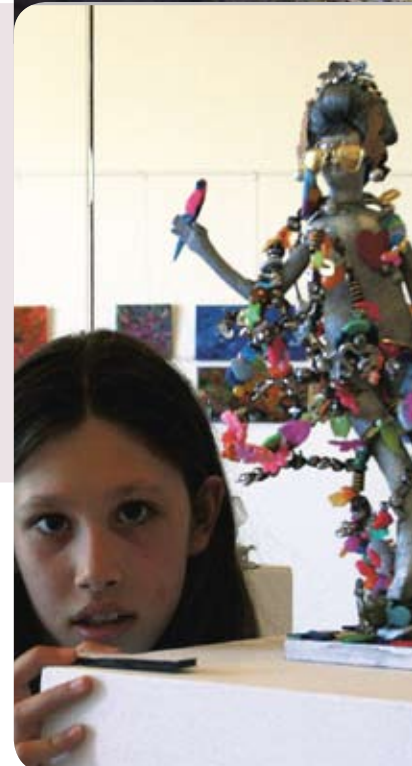
